The position also investigates and determines the manner and cause of all sudden, violent, or unusual deaths due to apparent natural causes in cases where the decedent has not been seen by a physician within 20 days prior to death, or where the attending physician is unable to determine the cause of death. The Chief Deputy Medical Examiner is a licensed physician and board-certified Forensic Pathologist in the State of California. Under administrative direction, this class is responsible for acting as principal assistant to the Chief Medical Examiner.
